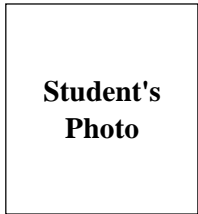

Dear Parents

The Almanac is introduced for you and school staff to communicate effectively. It is essential that you go through your child's almanac every day. Do sign the remarks, if any, so that we know what you have read them.

Visit to School

Parents are encouraged to visit the school to discuss the child's performance with the teacher concerned with prior appointment and confirmation. As part of the school's security system, all visitors to the school will check-in at the security office. Visitors will be given a badge for identification. After completion of the visit, visitors are required to return the badge to the security office and check out of the building. This procedure must be strictly observed for the safety of students. Parents and guardians are not allowed to see students or teachers during class hours without the permission of the Person-

In Charge. Accordingly, all visitors are requested to come to the school only with prior appointment and confirmation. Mobile phone, Camera and Electronic gadgets are not allowed in the school Campus for security reasons. You are requested to deposit the same at the security office. Parents should enter the campus in formal attire.

APPEAL TO PARENTS

- Kindly send your child in clean and ironed clothes/complete uniform daily.
- Leave application, sick leave need to be communicated to the teacher through the almanac.
- The child should be brought to school on time. If the child reaches the school earlier, parents should not leave the school premises until the teacher takes charge.
- The school authorities should be informed about the identity of the person who will be bringing and taking the child from school every day.
- The school expects the child to attend school regularly. If the child remains absent (for more than 2 days), the teachers should be informed in writing at the earliest.
- No child will be allowed to leave before the scheduled hours unless a valid reason is cited.
- Parents are not allowed to enter the classroom during school hours.
- Parents should not send any valuable items with their children to the school. The school authorities will not be responsible for the loss of the same.
- We enjoy celebrating children's birthday in school, but we request parents to co-operate with the school authorities. The class can celebrate the child's birthday by

wishing him/her and making a card for the child. Parents must avoid giving sweets/toys/party favours to children individually.

- Parents are expected to read the notices from time to time regarding holidays and other activities of the school.
- Parent-teacher meetings are held to keep the parents updated with their child's development at school. It provides a platform for the parents to discuss their child's progress as well as concerns with the teacher. Hence, it is advised that both the parents attend all parent-teacher meetings as arranged at the school from time to time.

COMMUNICATION BETWEEN SCHOOL AND PARENTS

- Parents are expected to communicate to the school, if there is any change in address and contact details.
- Parents wishing to meet the teachers are requested to seek an appointment by either mentioning the reason in the school Almanac of the student or by telephoning the front office of the school. Parents should not come to the school premises during school working hours unless it is with prior appointments or in case of extreme emergencies.
- Parents are requested to ensure that student's Name, Standard and section are clearly mentioned in all the letters addressed to the school.
- Parents should acknowledge the receipt of each circular issued by the school by signing at the respective section in the Almanac. Whenever the circular requires a response from the parent, the same has to be completed and returned through the child by the required time and date.
- If the parent has concerns or is worried about a certain issue with regard to his/her child, he/she can approach the class teacher for the same. The parent can take a prior appointment, with the class teacher and briefly inform them about his/her concerns.
- If the parent feels that the concern needs immediate attention and cannot wait for an appointment, he/she can approach the school directly.
- The school assures the parents that their child is as important to the school as all the other children and that the school will do its best towards giving what is right for the child. Parents are thus requested to approach the school in calm and composed manners so that the school along with the parent can work towards finding a solution to his/her concerns.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

- All students must carry their school Almanac and Identity Card to school every day. Students, who come to school on their own, should arrive well before the reporting time.
- Students, who come escorted, should never leave before the escort arrives. In case of any delay, they should report to the school's office.
- Students are allowed to use the school telephone only with the permission of the class teacher.
- The school does not permit the celebration of birthdays in the school campus. Distribution of sweets / goodies / gifts is not permitted for birthday celebrations. No other outside food is permitted.
- Use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Bullying, ragging and extortion is prohibited. There is NO violence at any time.
- Students are expected to be polite and proper with all the staff on campus.
- Alcohol, tobacco, cigarettes, drugs, firearms, lethal weapons, pornographic literature, matches, lighters etc are totally forbidden.
- Electronic items like Discman, Walkman, iPod, Cell Phones are not permitted.
- Cash is not permitted and betting in any form is prohibited.
- There should be no distinction in terms of religion, caste, income group, region, colour, creed, etc.

DRESS AND APPEARANCE

- Students are expected to dress and behave in a manner appropriate to the membership of the school and are required to be neat and clean in their general appearance.
- While on the school campus, or in school transport, all students must be in their designated school uniform.
- If for some reason a child is unable to wear his/her uniform, special permission needs to be availed from the class teacher.
- Students must wear neat school shoes only.
- Students are not allowed to wear ostentatious or jewellery, watches, wristbands, chains, and similar accessories.

RULES-ATTENDANCE

- If the child remains absent, notify the school immediately.
- A child is expected to attend school regularly. A child who is irregular in attendance (for more than two weeks continuously) without any valid reason may be asked to withdraw from the school.

- It is important to inculcate the value of punctuality from an early age. Emphasize the value of reaching on time to school each day and help the child achieve the same.
- If the child is suffering from any of the following, he/she should not be sent to school (The school should be informed about the absence). Also, if the child develops any of the following after coming to school, he/she will be temporarily excluded from the class and sent home as soon as possible.
 - Fever with behavioural changes
 - Uncontrollable cough
 - Persistent crying
 - Different breathing, wheezing
 - Diarrhoea
 - Vomiting (more than 2 times)
 - Persistent abdominal pain
 - Mouth sores with drooling
 - Scabies
 - Tuberculosis
 - Skin boils

ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL

1. New admissions are subject to availability of seats.
2. Parents will be required to pay the prescribed school fees for the term in advance. The fees once paid will not be refunded even if the child, for any reason, leaves the school immediately after the admission.
3. Student transfer is subject to the availability of seat at the school and the parent can contact the school management for details about the same.
4. School Leaving Certificate will be issued only after the parent/guardian applied for the same on or before 12th February every year.
5. School Leaving Certificate will not be issued till the parent pays all outstanding fees and before the completion of annual examination.

MEDICAL

- The school will not be held responsible for any injuries suffered by a student or for his or her loss of life during activities such as games, sports, gymnastics, swimming, sailing or mountaineering expeditions, camping, etc.
- All the students are expected to attend school on the opening day after every vacation. Those absent because of sickness must submit a medical certificate before they join the class.
- A child returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease should produce a fitness certificate from a doctor.
